

## **RESOLUTION #18-11**

## A RESOLUTION OPPOSING OFFSHORE OIL AND GAS DRILLING AND EXPLORATION INCLUDING SEISMIC TESTING

WHEREAS, the United States Department of the Interior has announced a proposal to allow oil and gas drilling and exploration and seismic testing in the Atlantic Ocean off the shore of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, when responding to the Draft Proposed OCS Oil and Gas Leasing Program 2010-2015 that included the same areas proposed in the current plan, the USDOD found "significant conflicts" and discouraged oil and gas activity in the majority of the sales area; and

**WHEREAS**, the loss of training grounds would be detrimental to our military by making it difficult to perform their duties, and therefore, proving dangerous to the nation; and

WHEREAS, the health of the waters off of coastal Virginia is imperative for tourism and the regional economy; and

**WHEREAS**, Governor Ralph S. Northam and the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission have announced their opposition to offshore drilling off of the coast of Virginia; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City of Council of Williamsburg strongly opposes offshore oil and gas drilling and exploration including seismic testing off the shore of Virginia.
