12 13	To express the District of Columbia's opposition to seismic airgun blasting and offshore drilling
14	activities.

16	WHEREAS, the U.S. Bureau of Ocean Energy Management is currently in the process of
17	trying to open the Mid- and South Atlantic Ocean to exploration and development of offshore oil
18	and gas including risky methods, such as seismic airgun blasting;
19 20	WHEREAS, seismic airguns fire frequent, intense blasts of compressed air, one of the
20 21	loudest man-made sounds in the ocean, that could prove harmful to or injure and kill marine
21 22	mammals, fish, and other marine life;
23	
24	WHEREAS, seismic airgun sounds can be heard up to 2,500 miles from the source under
24 25 26	some propagation conditions, farther than the distance from Washington, D.C. to Las Vegas;

27 28	WHEREAS, the full impact of seismic airgun blasting and offshore drilling in the Atlantic Ocean are not yet fully understood by scientists, the oil and gas industry, or the Federal
29	Government;

31	WHEREAS, exploratory and commercial drilling, extraction, and transportation of
32	offshore oil and gas resources pose a significant risk of oil spills and leakage of other toxic
33	waste;
34 25	WHEDEAS offshore drilling may require significant anchore infrastructure such as
35 36	WHEREAS, offshore drilling may require significant onshore infrastructure, such as pipelines or refineries, which may harm the character of our coast;
37	pipelines of refineries, which may harm the character of our coast,
38	WHEREAS, the District of Columbia endeavors to be a good steward of the region's
39	environment and its resources;

41	WHEREAS, the District of Columbia recognizes that the Chesapeake Bay is a major
42 43	historical, cultural, economic, and ecological treasure to our city and surrounding region;
43 44	WHEREAS, residents of the District of Columbia enjoy close proximity to pristine beach
45	areas in Virginia, Maryland, and Delaware which are at direct risk from offshore drilling

 activities;

WHEREAS, offshore drilling activities pose threats to coastal wetlands in the Chesapeake Bay region, which are of intrinsic ecological value for numerous migratory bird species, serve as essential nursery habitats for recreational and commercially important fisheries, and act as natural buffers from storm surge and hurricanes;

WHEREAS, the exploration and development of oil and gas off the Mid- and South Atlantic coast will not effectively address the long-term energy needs of our country;

WHEREAS, the District of Columbia has set a goal of increasing the use of renewable energy to make up 50% of the District's energy supply by 2030, and offshore oil drilling will not assist in achieving that goal;

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "District of Columbia Seismic Airgun Blasting and Offshore Drilling Opposition Recognition Resolution of 2016".

Sec. 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the first date of publication in the District of Columbia Register.
