11	WHEREAS, the United States government has expressed interest in opening the			
12	Atlantic Ocean and Eastern Gulf of Mexico to offshore oil and gas development and			
13	exploration, including risky methods such as seismic airgun blasting; and,

15 16	WHEREAS, seismic airguns fire intense blasts of compressed air, one of the			
16 1 7	loudest manmade sounds in the ocean, every 10-12 seconds for days, weeks, or months

19	WHEREAS, seismic airgun noise has been shown to harm and injure dolphins			
20 21	whales, endangered sea turtles, fish, and other marine life; and,			
22	WHEREAS exploratory and commercial drilling extraction and transportation at			
23	WHEREAS, exploratory and commercial drilling, extraction, and transportation of offshore oil and gas resources pose a significant risk of oil spills and chronic leakage; and,			
24	onshore on and gas resources pose a significant risk of oit spills and chronic leakage; and,			
25	WHEREAS, eventual offshore drilling may require significant onshore			
26	infrastructure, such as pipelines or refineries, which would harm the character of the coast;			
27	and,

29	WHEREAS, offshore drilling activities pose threats to treasured vacation			
30	destinations on Florida's Coasts, which are of intrinsic economic value for numerous			
31	industries, provide essential nursery habitats for recreational and commercially important			
32	fisheries, and act as natural buffers from storm surge and hurricanes; and,

34	WHEREAS, the city of Hallandale Beach recognizes that the tourism and fishing			
35	industries, which depend on a healthy and vibrant coastal environment, both serve as			
36	major economic drivers benefiting the current and future residents, property owners, and			
37	visitors to Florida; and,

39	WHEREAS, the city of Hallandale Beach endeavors to be a good steward of the			
40	state and region's environment and its resources; and,			
41				
42	WHEREAS, exploration and development of oil and gas resources off the coast of			
43	Florida will not effectively address the long-term energy needs of our country; and,			
44				
45	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best			
46	interest of the City and its residents to recommend that it would be more economically and			
47	ecologically responsible to pursue non-polluting sources of renewable energy such as			
48	solar and wind, that pose less risk to the coastal environment and economic health before			
49	using uncertain methods of seismic airgun blasting for offshore oil and gas deposits.

51	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY			
52	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

54	SECTION 1. Offshore oil and gas drilling and exploration, including seismic			
55	airgun blasting, will put Florida's environment, beaches, marine resources and local			
56	economies at risk; therefore the Mayor and City Commission hereby expresses its			
57	opposition to these activities and urges the federal government not to pursue such			
58	practices off Florida's coast.

60	SECTION 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to convey a copy of this resolution			
61	to all relevant parties.

63	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon			
64	its passage and adoption.
