Dominique Cano-Stocco is a campaign director at Oceana, the largest international advocacy group working solely to protect the world's oceans. Cano-Stocco's responsibilities include directing Oceana's responsible fishing campaign, specifically working to protect marine life such as sharks and sea turtles and to reduce bycatch in commercial fisheries.

Prior to joining Oceana, Cano-Stocco served in the Congressional Youth Leadership Council, The Clinton Administration White House, Pepperdine University, founded Big Wave Consulting – a government, community and media relations firm, and most recently served as the Director of Advocacy and Government Relations for UC San Diego.

She has also served as a board member with the League of Conservation Voters San Diego and has lobbied legislators to increase protections for the California coastal and marine environment during California Ocean Lobby Day.

Cano-Stocco received her bachelor's degree in political science from the University of California San Diego and has a master's degree from the prestigious Marine Biodiversity and Conservation program at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography.
