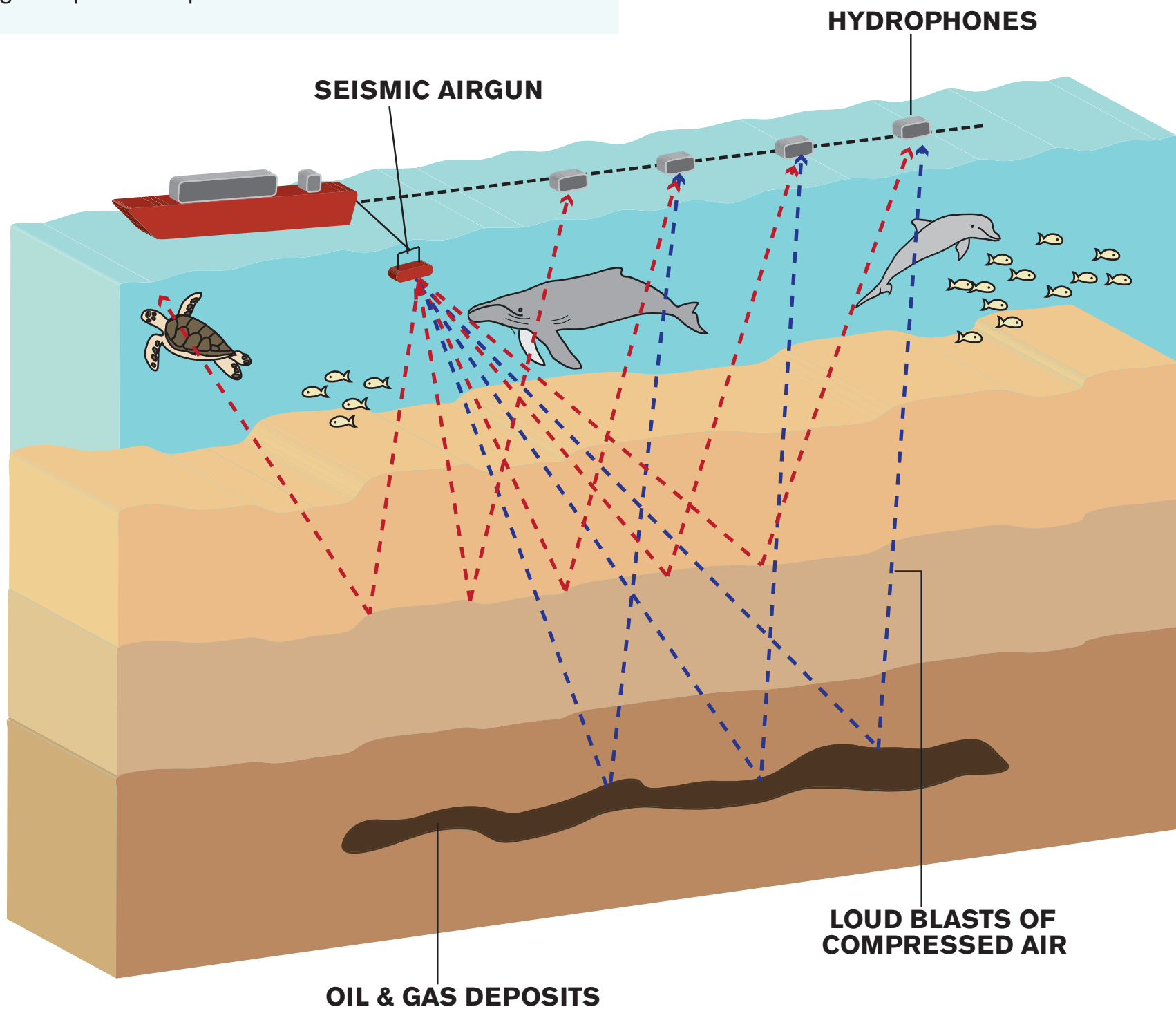


HOW IT WORKS

Seismic airgun blasting is used to locate oil and gas deposits deep below the ocean floor.



Vessels tow large arrays of seismic airguns which shoot extremely loud blasts of compressed air through the ocean and miles under the seafloor, **every ten seconds, 24 hours a day, for days to weeks on end.**
