The potential short-term benefits to energy companies do not outweigh the long-term threats to coastal livelihoods, local industries, and our natural resources.

We urge the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management to take these economic concerns seriously and to prioritize the protection of our coasts in the upcoming leasing program. We also call on our elected officials in Congress to support policies that safeguard our shorelines and reject any efforts to expand offshore oil and gas development.
